Aspire gives students who have gone above and beyond through leadership and volunteering an early offer to La Trobe. They're also rewarded with a minimum ATAR, scholarship opportunities and more.

Previous leadership or volunteering experience still counts – so even if a student has given up their volunteer work in Year 12, they're still eligible to apply.
