FAQ'S

What do Aspire students need to do after receiving their results?

If a student would like to formalise their Aspire offer, it MUST be the highest eligible course preference on their list. Students must read through the instructions provided in their conditional offer letter to finalise their offer and be eligible to accept and enrol in their course.

A few things to note:

- the Aspire ATAR is raw ATAR
- prerequisite study scores are the RAW scores
- Aspire Year 11 Conditional Entry has no ATAR requirement, only prerequisite requirements
- There will be no Aspire Second Chance this year. Students can apply for pathway options through usual VTAC avenue
- Aspire offers are only valid for round 1 offers.

A student has accepted their offer or enrolled. What now?

Offer letters to students usually include a lapse date. They'll need to accept before their offer lapses. Once they've accepted their offer, they're a current student and can contact [ASK La Trobe](#) for help with enrollment. Contact details should be in their offer letter or [visit latrobe.edu.au/students/ask-us](https://www.latrobe.edu.au/students/ask-us)

My student hasn't met the requirements for their Aspire conditional offer. What now?

If students don't meet/fulfill the requirements of their Aspire conditional offer they'll need to reconsider their VTAC preference list and add a pathway or alternate course. Aspire conditional offers are contingent on meeting admissions requirements.

How do I find the correct pathways?

How do ATAR adjustments work at La Trobe?

On application, La Trobe Admissions staff will assess an applicant's circumstances to confirm their eligibility for the available adjustments. A maximum of 20 aggregate adjustment points can be granted. The aggregate points are added to their combined study scores and their ATAR is recalculated.
