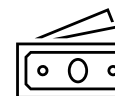

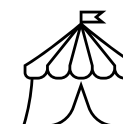

When you study nursing at La Trobe, you'll develop a strong foundation in acute care, chronic illness, First Nations health, mental health, rehabilitation, community and emergency care, biosciences, and research.

If your calling is midwifery, you'll learn the fundamentals of nursing and midwifery, and then build on this with further study in First Nations and intercultural health, midwifery care across antenatal, intrapartum and postnatal periods, acute nursing and mental health, and illness.

The School of Nursing and Midwifery's simulation laboratories provide a fully immersive hospital experience, so you can confidently build your skills in a safe and supportive learning environment.

You'll then put your skills to use in real-world settings. Melbourne students can undertake placements in leading Victorian hospitals including The Alfred Hospital, The Austin Hospital, The Royal Melbourne Hospital and The Northern Hospital, or with our leading maternity partners, such as The Royal Women's Hospital, Mercy Health, and Joan Kirner Women's and Children's Hospital.

Regional students can undertake clinical placements at a selection of our 100+ industry partners, including Albury-Wodonga Health, Bendigo Health, Goulburn Valley Health and Mildura Base Hospital.

CLINICAL-BASED LEARNING

Our clinical approach is unique, featuring dedicated academic teaching and research spaces that have been established by the University, and embedded in partner hospitals.

Here, students receive practice-based education from their first year of study, augmented by a fully immersive experience that socialises them into the health care environment.

There is a chronic shortage of medical services in rural, regional and remote areas. La Trobe University, in partnership with the University of Melbourne, has designed its **Bachelor of Biomedical Science (Medical)** to address this crisis. The end-to-end rural medical training program combines the fields of biology, pharmacology and medicine. You'll learn about the human body, its structure and its functions. This includes how disease manifests and how drug strategies are used to treat disease.

The course is offered exclusively to 15 rural and regional students. Graduates will receive a guaranteed pathway¹ to the **Doctor of Medicine (Rural Pathway)** at the University of Melbourne in Shepparton.

WHY STUDY AT LA TROBE?

- Provides a guaranteed pathway¹ for rural and regional students to study medicine in a rural setting.
- Learn valuable skills required to help those living in regional communities.
- New \$2m science laboratories at the Albury Wodonga Campus.
- New high-tech simulation learning spaces designed to foster interprofessional and scenario-based learning, providing students with authentic rural healthcare experiences.

COURSE OVERVIEW

Learn how the fields of cell and molecular biology, biochemistry, anatomy, physiology, pharmacology and immunology can be applied to understand and treat disease.

Develop the practical skills needed to explore the underlying molecular basis of acute and chronic illnesses. Investigate how to apply biomedical research and convey scientific information.

CAREER OUTCOMES

When you complete your **Bachelor of Biomedical Science (Medical)** at La Trobe, you'll be guaranteed¹ a Bonded Medical Place in the Doctor of Medicine at the University of Melbourne, Shepparton. This rural medical pathway is intended to address shortages of doctors in regional and rural areas.

Students can continue to the Doctor of Medicine if they obtain the required Weighted Average Mark (WAM)¹.

If you don't proceed to the Doctor of Medicine, you'll graduate well-prepared for roles in biomedical, biotechnology and pharmaceutical industries as well as in hospitals and government departments. You will also be suitable for roles in medical sales and health communication.

ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

To be eligible for selection, you must meet the following requirements:

- Have lived in regional or rural areas for five years continuously or 10 years cumulatively.
- VCE Units 3 and 4: a study score of at least 30 in English (EAL) or at least 25 in English other than EAL.
- Have a minimum unadjusted ATAR of 80.
- Have preferably completed Years 11 and 12 at a regional school.
- Submission of an online rurality form demonstrating evidence of regional living. latrobe.edu.au/study/apply/undergrad/rurality

SELECTION PROCESS

Selected students will progress to a joint La Trobe and University of Melbourne selection process. This involves multiple mini interviews (MMIs) conducted in December and January.

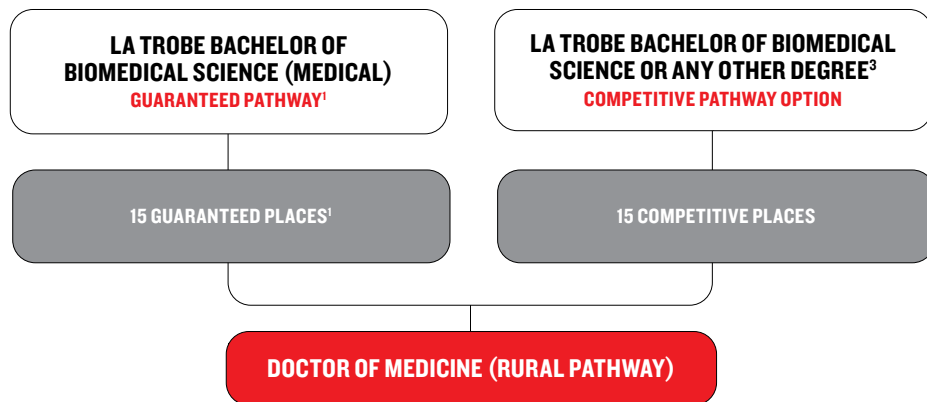

For Year 12 applicants selection for interview will be based on the applicant's Rurality Form and on their La Trobe Entrance Rank (LTER), determined using official Year 11 results and the School Endorsement Form (for December interviews) or on the applicant's ATAR (for January interviews). The number of applicants interviewed will depend on size of eligible applicant pool and interview availability.

VICTORIA'S FIRST END-TO-END RURAL MEDICAL PATHWAY



La Trobe University and the University of Melbourne have partnered to deliver a unique rural medical pathway program across Bendigo, Albury- Wodonga and Shepparton.

The 15 students accepted into the Bachelor of Biomedical Science (Medical) program each year will be guaranteed¹ entry into the 4-year Doctor of Medicine (Rural Pathway) at the University of Melbourne's Shepparton Campus. Students will study and live in the recently constructed, \$6.5m student accommodation and expanded learning facilities.

Melbourne Medical School (MMS) is the oldest medical school in Australia, ranked #1 in Australia for clinical medicine, public health and psychology and 14th in the world for clinical medicine². MMS is internationally renowned for global leadership in teaching and training, health

research, policy and practice. It also has partnerships with leading hospitals and medical research institutes and centres, both locally and internationally.

At the University of Melbourne, students will form the Doctor of Medicine (Rural Pathway). This pathway provides training for students interested in practicing medicine in rural or regional locations. The Doctor of Medicine (Rural Pathway) comprises a group of 30 students. 15 of these will be preselected from La Trobe's Bachelor of Biomedical Science (Medical) undergraduate degree, while the remainder will be open to other regional students. Rural Pathway students spend the third year of the MD course learning specialties in a primary health care setting in regional Victoria. This includes Aged Care, Women's Health, Child and Adolescent Health, Mental Health and General Practice.



This course is extremely special to not only the individuals completing it, but also the rural communities that we will be able to work in one day. It is incredible to think that one day we will be able to increase healthcare access, possibly giving back to a town that shaped us as a person. This course provides opportunities that country kids have always dreamt of. The small cohort allows students to connect with their teachers, being able to receive support at a drop of a hat. You're also able to create strong friendships with your peers, all aiming to achieve the same goals. I know this degree is going to ensure that I become a knowledgeable and empathetic doctor for rural communities, helping to fill the void of healthcare access.
