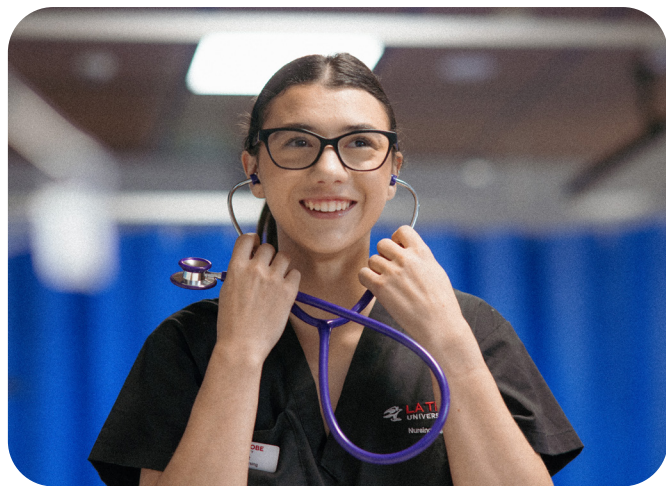

SELECTION CRITERIA

All applicants will complete a situation judgement test to support selection into teaching programs. This is a requirement for initial teacher training courses in Victoria and aims to assess an applicants personal and professional attributes. Completion of either the [CASPer Test](#) or [AFTA Test](#).

PREREQUISITES

VCE: Units 1 and 2: satisfactory completion in one of Maths: General Mathematics, Maths: Mathematical Methods or Maths: Specialist Mathematics or Units 3 and 4: any Mathematics
Units 3 and 4: a study score of at least 30 in English (EAL) or at least 25 in English other than EAL.

HSC: One of English Standard, English Advanced (Band 3), English as an Additional Language or Dialect (Band 4). Any 2 units of Mathematics.

ABOUT

Students who enrol in our Bachelor of Education can choose to major in early childhood and primary, primary, or secondary education. Before they choose, they can explore all levels in their first year to make sure they find their best fit.

They'll build a skillset in digital learning, learning contexts, literacy and numeracy, student development and classroom readiness, while exploring the most up-to-date and proven approaches to teaching. They'll learn how to design inclusive learning environments, benefit from mentoring and get real-world experiences through placements.

The Bachelor of Education is accredited by the Victorian Institute of Teaching (VIT) and approved by the Australian Children's Education & Care Quality Authority (ACECQA) for the Early Childhood and Primary major stream.

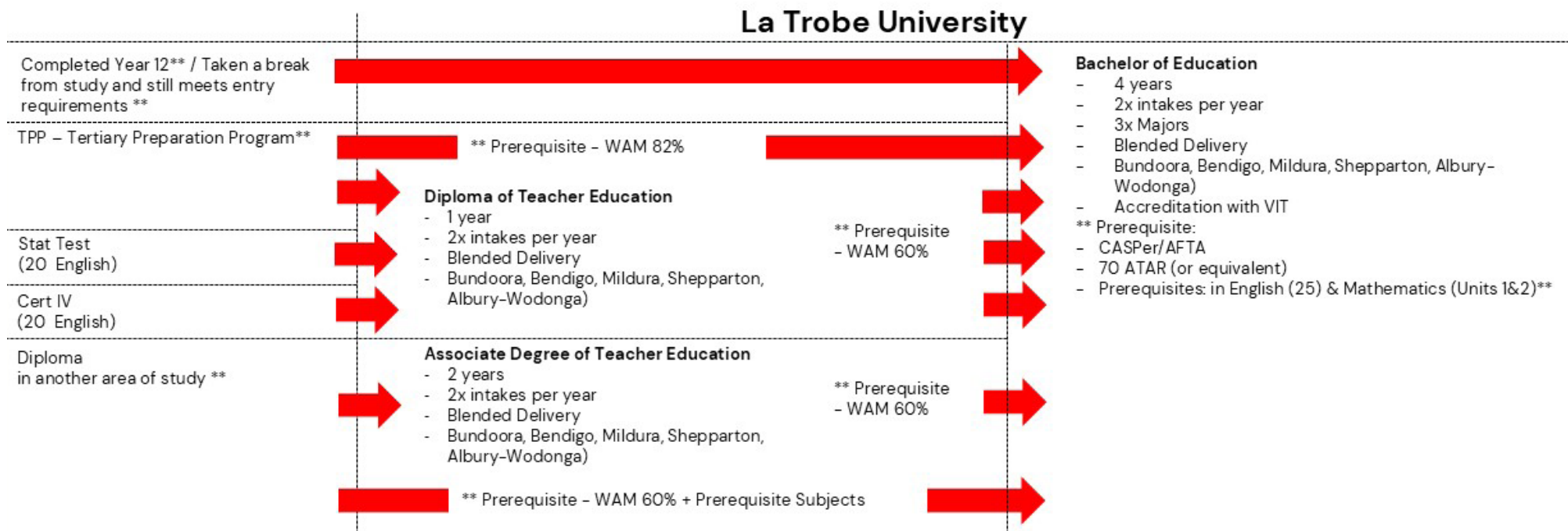
