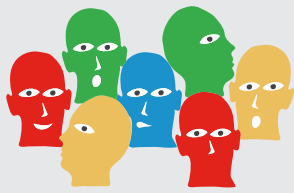
Campus life and events

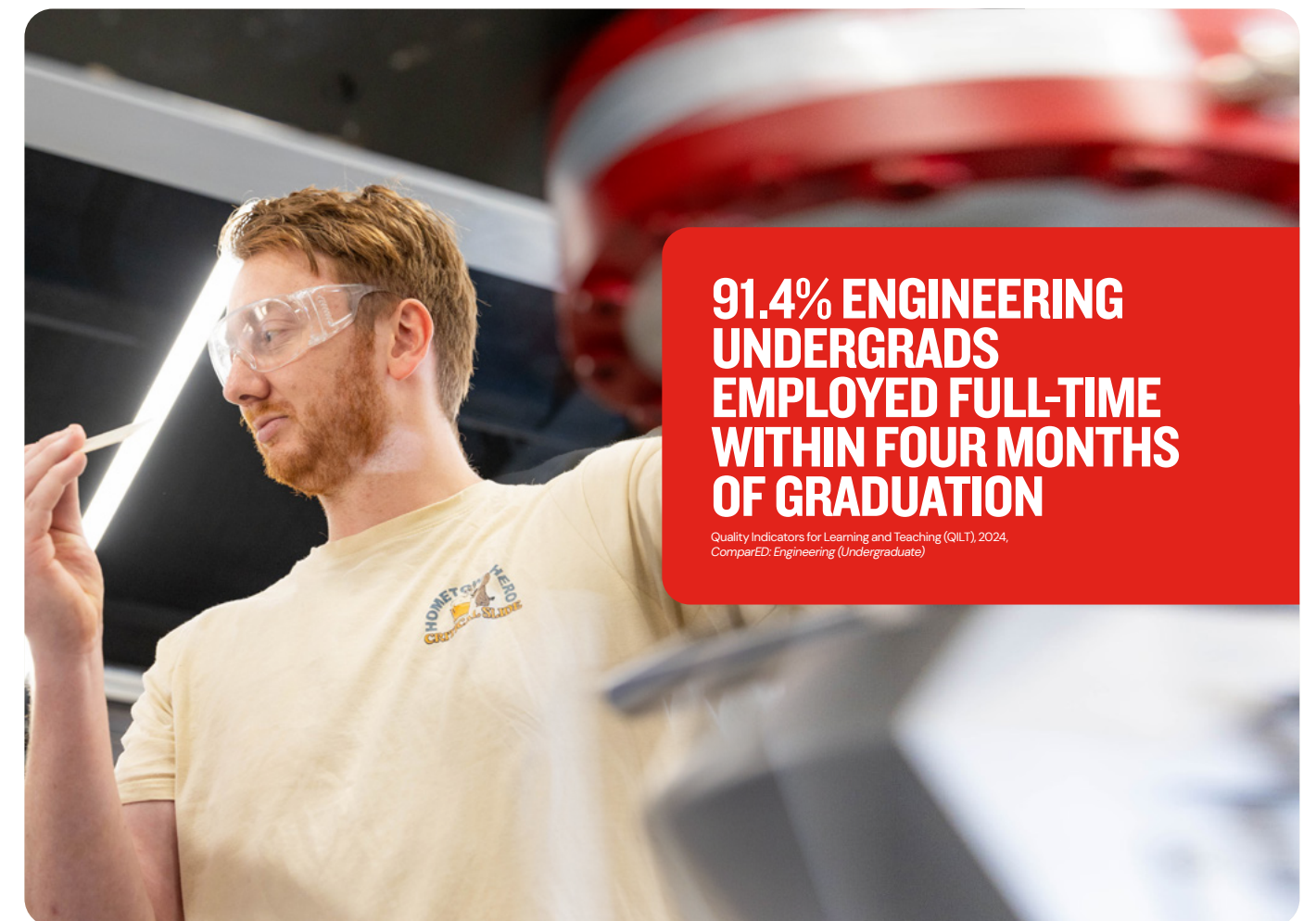

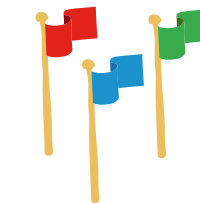

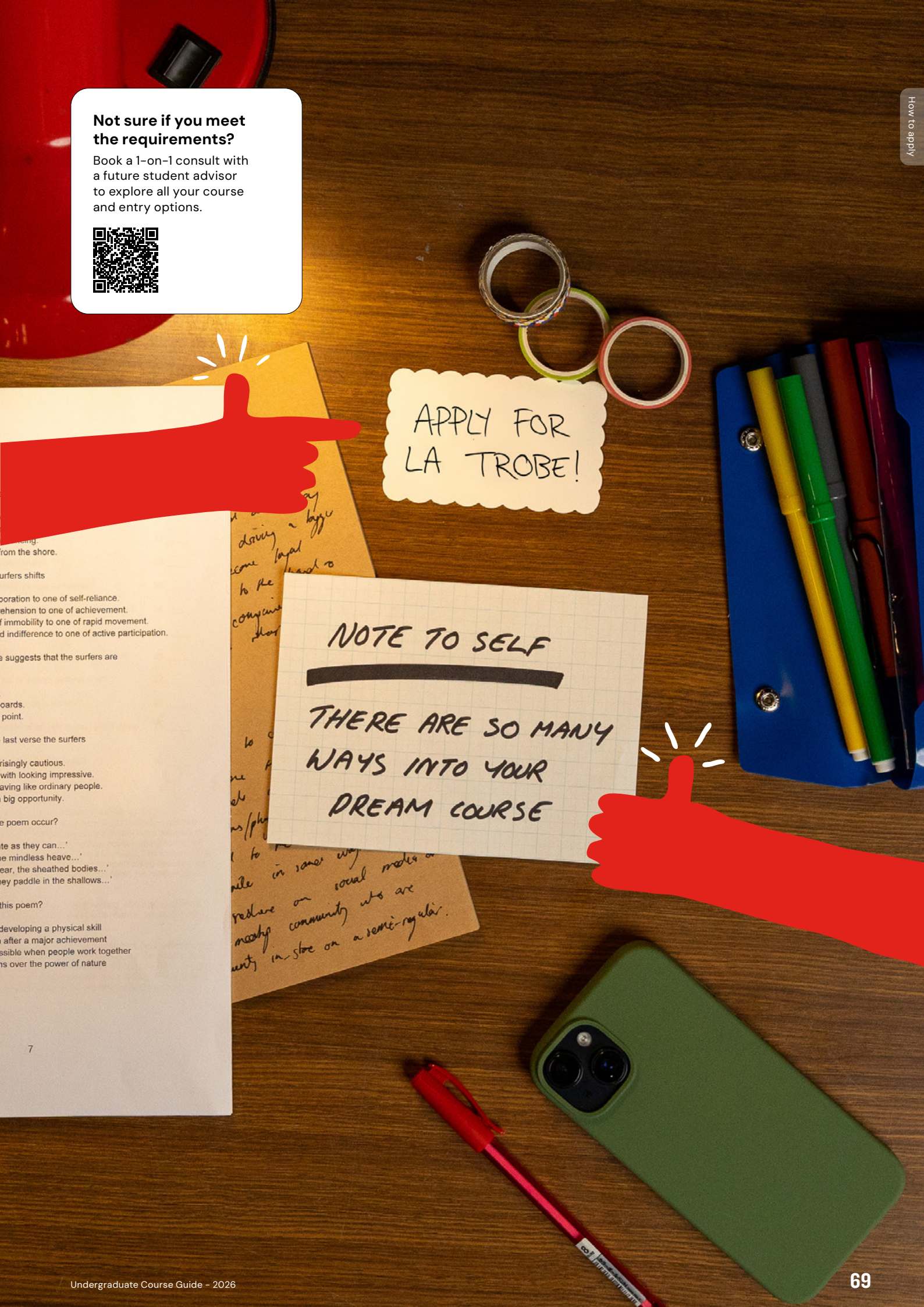

Can I apply direct?

If you're not in Year 12 and only applying for one course, you can apply directly to La Trobe without using VTAC or UAC. Just head to your course's web page and follow the instructions to apply online¹.

KEY TERMS

Adjustment factors

Adjustment factors are additional factors we consider in your application based on your personal circumstances and performance. Adjustment factors may be added to your raw ATAR.

Aspire ATAR

If you're applying for an Aspire Early Entry Program, you may be eligible for an Aspire ATAR – the score you need to lock in a conditional offer. An Aspire ATAR is usually lower than a regular ATAR – it's our way of encouraging you to reach higher than you thought you could.

Your conditional offer may be converted to a full offer if you meet the Aspire ATAR and your Aspire program requirements, as well as any prerequisites from the course you're applying for. Some Aspire programs also allow you to access a La Trobe Entrance Score, another alternative to a standard ATAR.

Australian tertiary admissions rank (ATAR)

A number between 0.00 and 99.95 to rank your Year 12 results against other students' results.

Commonwealth supported place (CSP)

With a CSP, the government pays for a part of your course, and you'll only need to pay for your share. This is known as the 'student contribution amount'. All domestic undergraduate places at La Trobe are CSPs.

Early entry programs

Early entry programs give you an alternative way to get into your dream course by considering factors like community contribution, achieving good results in Year 11 or taking extra uni studies.

Entry requirements

Each course has different requirements to be granted entry. These requirements are usually made up of qualifications, subjects or exam grades.

HECS

Most students don't need to pay their student contribution amount upfront. If you're an Australian citizen, or eligible under other conditions, your payment will be deferred under the HECS-HELP scheme. HECS-HELP is a government loan that you don't need to repay until your income reaches a certain level.

Honours

Honours studies are advanced studies attached to undergraduate degrees that give you a higher qualification than a three-year degree. Many people do Honours so they can continue to postgraduate studies.

Industry placements

Also known as Work Based Learning (WBL) or Work Integrated Learning (WIL), an industry placement is a combination of educational theory in the classroom plus real-world experience in a workplace.

La Trobe entrance score

If you complete any subjects or micro-subjects for Year 11 and Year 12 students as part of our Aspire Achieve Plus, Aspire Advance or Aspire Prepare early entry programs, you'll also gain access to a La Trobe Entrance Score as an alternative to both a standard and Aspire ATAR.

We've looked closely at the performance of students in these subjects and micro-subjects to apply a score associated with future performance and believe it's a great indicator of how you'll succeed at uni.

Major

A major is a way to focus your undergraduate course in a 120-credit point sequence of related subjects spread across its duration. For some courses, you're required to choose a first major (also known as a cognate major) that adds a tag to your degree – like a Bachelor of Arts (Digital Media).

In other courses, majors are optional – as long as there's enough spare credit points and room in your timetable. This includes taking an optional second major from your course's discipline or an open access major from a completely different discipline.

Minor

A minor is an optional 60-credit point sequence of related subjects studied in your undergraduate course. If there's enough spare credit points in your course and room in your timetable, up to two minors can be taken in your course or first major's discipline, or you can take an open access minor from a completely different discipline.

Pathways

Pathways can help you enter your chosen course by studying another qualification first. For example, the Diploma of Arts could be a pathway to applying for the Bachelor of Arts. Entry is based on competitive selection and entry requirements. See our website for more details.

Prerequisites

Prerequisites are subjects you must have previously completed to be eligible for consideration for a particular uni course.

Study score

This shows how well you performed in Units 3 and 4 of a subject compared to everyone else in Victoria who took the subject. The mean study score is 30, above 38 puts you in the top 15% and the maximum study score is 50.
