CHANGE OF PREFERENCE FAQ'S

A STUDENT DIDN'T REACH THE ATAR THEY HOPED FOR, WHAT PATHWAY COURSES CAN THEY CHOOSE?

Visit the course page for suggested pathways or use our [pathways finder tool](#). Pathways are based on competitive selection. Some of the popular pathways we often recommend by interest area are:

- **HEALTH** – Bachelor of Health Sciences to pathway into most allied health courses or postgraduate study. Bachelor of Sport and Exercise Science for Physiotherapy, Diploma of Rural Health for Bachelor of Nursing and Bachelor of Biomedicine or Biomedical Science for Bachelor of Dental Science (Honours).
- **LAW** – Bachelor of Arts to pathway into Law, or if students are considering a double degree to start in the other degree first e.g. Bachelor of Business and transfer into Business / Law double.
- **ENGINEERING** – Associate Diploma of Engineering Technology to pathway into Bachelor of Civil Engineering (Honours).
- **IT** – Diploma of Information Technology to pathway into Bachelor of Information Technology.
- **EDUCATION** – Associate Degree of Teacher Education to pathway into Bachelor of Education.
- **PSYCHOLOGY** – Bachelor of Psychological Science to pathway into Bachelor of Psychology (Honours)

HOW CAN ADJUSTMENT FACTORS BOOST AN ATAR?

The VTAC equity schemes (SEAS) & scholarships covers a range of access and equity programs. It adjusts a students ATAR in recognition of circumstances that may have affected their education.

They may receive additional points depending on their circumstances. The aggregate points are added to their combined study scores and their ATAR is recalculated. Use our [ATAR Adjustment Factors Calculator](#) to estimate how they can boost their ATAR score.

HOW DO STUDENTS FORMALISE THEIR ASPIRE CONDITIONAL OFFER?

The conditional offer becomes a formal offer during the first round of offers via VTAC in December, (for some courses this may be round 1 in January) provided the student meets all the course and Aspire ATAR requirements listed on their Aspire Conditional Offer.

To receive an unconditional course offer, students must:

- Meet the standard course prerequisites and any extra requirements for their chosen course
- Meet the Aspire ATAR for their course
- Place their Aspire course high in their VTAC preference list

Note:

Aspire Academic Impact and Aspire Everyday Impact Conditional Offers have no ATAR requirement, only prerequisite requirements.

WHAT HAPPENS IF A STUDENT DOESN'T MEET THE ATAR REQUIREMENT FOR THEIR ASPIRE COMMUNITY IMPACT OFFER?

For Community Impact applications if a student does not meet the minimum Aspire ATAR, which is based upon the Raw ATAR, they may still be eligible for selection through the standard process if their ATAR is adjusted where they are eligible for Adjustment Factors.

For example, if they receive an Aspire offer for the Bachelor of Business with an Aspire ATAR requirement of 50 and they receive an ATAR of 46 – while they would not meet the direct conditions of their Aspire conditional offer, they may be eligible for adjustment factors and may still receive an offer for the course through the regular selection process. Or they can apply for an alternate pathway option through VTAC. Visit the course page for suggested pathways or use our [pathways finder tool](#).

OTHER ASPIRE POINTS TO NOTE:

- Aspire offers are only valid for round 1 VTAC offers in December (for some courses this may be round 1 in January).
- The Aspire ATAR is the raw ATAR
- Prerequisite study scores are the scaled score.
